Beltsville, Maryland (May 3, 2010) — Rockwood Color Pigments & Services announces a global price increase of 5% to 10% effective June 1, 2010 for selected elements of its full range of pigments to include: iron oxides (synthetic and natural), carbon blacks, chromium oxide greens and specialty pigment types.

Rockwood has consolidated operations, improved productivity, negotiated favorable transportation contracts and streamlined the supply chain in order to maintain stable product pricing for two years. The recent accelerating increase of raw material costs, energy prices and transportation charges necessitates a revision of its current pricing structure.
